ADDENDUM # 1

TO ALL BIDDERS:

You are hereby notified of the following changes to the above mentioned bid:

Please see the following questions and answers below:

- 1) In section 1.8.3, it is stated that the bid must be placed in a bid box. If we are using a courier service such as FedEx or UPS, they will not likely be able to provide this service. If the bid is delivered to the address given (1401 JFK Boulevard, Philadelphia, PA 19102), will someone be able to place our bid in the bid box or will the bid need to be hand delivered?*

Response: You may send the bid by courier and it will be placed in our bid box. But, you must place your bid in a sealed envelope and then place the sealed envelope in the courier service envelope. Be sure to include your company name and address, bid number and opening date.

- 2) In regards to the sample required as mentioned in section 1.10, would the sample entail sending you an entire speed cushion and speed table or only one modular section of the speed cushion or table?*

Response: A modular section of the speed table and speed cushion would be an acceptable sample.

- 3) The specifications (section 2.1), state that the speed cushions and tables should include steel anchors and plastic shields. We consider shields and anchors to be the same item. Would both steel and plastic meet these specifications?*

Response: Yes, steel and plastic would meet our specification, however we prefer steel.

- 4) *Furthermore, vendor does not use grommets on holes that are close to the extremities of the modules as the rubber is too thin at these locations that a plug will not fit. We have strategically placed these holes to prevent the rubber from curling which is what happens if these holes are placed where the rubber is thicker. Please contact us if you need further information or documentation explaining why the holes are placed so close to the extremity.*

Response: We will contact if we should require additional information, once we have reviewed the submitted samples.

- 5) *We would like to submit both a 7' length option and 10.5' length option for the speed cushion. Should we submit two bids or include both options in the same bid?*

Response: Both options should be included in the same bid

- 6) *A - Our standard warranty for our product is 2 years. The specification in section 2.3.1, state that the warranty for the speed cushions must be of 5 years. Does this warranty cover snow plow damage?*

Response: No, the warranty does not have to include snow plow damage.

B – Should the warranty also include the reflective taping of the speed cushion?


Response: Yes, the warranty is to include the reflective taping of the speed cushion.

- 7) *In section 2.3.2 regarding the speed tables, the specifications state that the warranty must be of two years. Is there a reason why the speed cushions have a 5 year warranty and the speed tables only have a 2 year warranty?*

Response: This is an error – statement should read:

“A FIVE year full replacement written warranty shall be provided. This product must carry the original equipment manufacturer warranty that will commence upon acceptance of the products by the City. During this period the vendor shall provide parts replacement to the City at no charge.”
