### **TO ALL BIDDERS:**

**You are hereby notified of the following changes to the above mentioned bid:**

Section 1.9 Bidder Qualification has been deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

#### 1.9 BIDDER QUALIFICATION:

##### 1.9.1 Competence of Bidder

Upon request of the City of Philadelphia, successful bidder(s) must be prepared to demonstrate competency in the repair of equipment for which a bid is submitted.

All facilities, equipment, staffing and/or samples of completed work may be inspected by the City of Philadelphia prior to award of contract for compliance with the intent of these specifications. Failure to comply shall be cause for rejection of bid.

To be considered for award vendors must meet or exceed the requirements as listed below:

- Repair facility large enough to be fully capable of restoring the damaged vehicle.
- Proof they have been in business for at least five (5) years performing services on specialized fire apparatus.
- Vendor shall have at time of bid opening have a minimum two (2) full time certified Emergency Vehicle Technicians (EVT).
- A certified ARFF technician is preferred, but not required. Upon award of contract, vendor shall agree to have at least one technician certified in ARFF within the first year of the contract.

**Training/Certification**

Vendor's repair technicians shall have two years of responsible journey level experience in mechanical and equipment maintenance and repair to fire apparatus equipment as well as heavy diesel and gasoline powered vehicles, and possess and hold current the following training and certification.

**Certification**

- ASE (Automotive Service Excellence) Medium Heavy Truck Certifications T1 through T8
- EVT (Fire Apparatus) Certification Level 2 or Master Level 3 certification
- High school diploma or GED

**Training**

To include but not be limited to the following:


- Chassis Repair
- Fire Pump Maintenance and Repair
- Aerial Maintenance and Repair
- Aerial Ladder Refurbishment
- Aerial Operators Maintenance Familiarization
- Mobile Apparatus Repair
- Knowledge of Practices, techniques, use of tools and equipment, diagnosis, repair and modification of specialized fire apparatus and related mechanical equipment including their components systems and computer systems.
- ARFF training by various manufacturers
