There are several different manufacturers who produce Poison Ivy/Oak/Sumac cleansers. Does the package need to be a 1oz tube. Packaging varies from ½ packets to 4oz bottles. Both the ½ oz packets and 4oz bottles have been used by various clients in their kit. If the ½ oz packets are of interest, we can put them into a unit box ( 2 or 4 per unit box) can be available.
