ADDENDUM # 1

TO ALL BIDDERS:

You are hereby notified of the following changes to the above mentioned bid:

The bid opening will be postponed/advanced to June 09, 2014 at 10:30 AM

Paragraph 2.3.2 has been deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

2.3.2 **SPEED TABLES:**

Vendor shall provide a flat-topped speed hump with room for the entire wheelbase of a passenger car to rest on top. The flat top design shall allow cars to maintain slightly higher speeds than they would on speed humps, slowing vehicles to estimated speeds of 20-25 miles per hour. The speed table shall be quick and easy to install by connecting the units and securing them to the road with anchors and bolts. **Reference Traffic Logix**

- Width shall be in the range of minimum 7 feet to about 10.5 feet maximum.
- Length shall be 9 feet minimum to a maximum of about 12 feet.
- Height of speed table shall be 3 inches.
- Each piece of speed table shall not weigh less than 40 pounds so as to assure stability to the system.
- Shall have a tensile strength of 500 psi.
- Shall have a Shore "A" Hardness of 65 or better.
- Specific Gravity of material shall be 1.0 or better.
- Entrance and exit gradient shall be in the range of 6% or 10%.

- Side gradient shall be in the range of 30% to 35%.
- Each set of speed table assembly shall yield about 7 feet (\pm 6 inches) in width, about 9 feet (\pm 6 inches), with a maximum length of 12 feet. It shall be 3 inches high above the existing roadway surface. Upon assembly, each speed table shall comprise about 1/3 length of up slope, 1/3 length of flat landing and followed by 1/3 length of down slope.
- Each module/panel shall be installed using (6)1/2" x 6" Hilti KH-EZ screw anchors embedded into pavement surface.
- A five year full replacement written warranty shall be provided. This product must carry the original equipment manufacturer warranty that will commence upon acceptance of the products by the City. During this period the vendor shall provide parts replacement to the City at no charge.
