Question #1

Paragraph 1.9.7 - Will this bid be impacted or influenced based on a vendors involvement with the M-BE, W-BE, DS-BE or LBE certification?

Answer:

As no M-BE, W-BE or DS-BE ranges have been established for this Invitation and Bid, bidders are requested to complete the "Voluntary Participation and Commitment Form (Bid)" located after page 1 of the bid.

Completion of this form will not, in any way, impact the City's determination concerning bidder's responsiveness to the requirements of the bid and the award process. The information provided in the "Voluntary Participation and Commitment Form (Bid)" will be for the City's information.

In order to determine eligibility to receive the 5% preference, Bidder must be certified at the time of the bid opening and must submit with the bid the Local Business Entity Certification number in Section 1.9.8 of their submittal.

Question #2

Paragraph 1.9.7 - How would a vendor know if it's competition is bidding with an M-BE, W-BE, DS-BE or LBE certification?

Answer:

This information would not be available until after all of the bids have been submitted on the bid opening date; an award has been made and all of the information has been released to the Procurement Department Public Information Unit.

Question #3

Paragraph 1.9.8- If subcontractors are utilized with a M-BE, W-BE, DS-BE or LBE vendor, are they to be certified also?

Question #4

Paragraph 1.9.8- If subcontractors are utilized with a M-BE, W-BE, DS-BE or LBE vendor, will the subcontractor's labor rates be that which is quoted in section 5.1, 5.2, 5.3 and 5.4?

Answer:

Question #5

In section 2.3, the bid states, "The vendor must prepare a written estimate of all work to be performed prior to commencement of repairs". Is the time that is spent issuing the estimate considered billable time? In order to make an accurate estimate, sometimes significant time is spent researching parts for the machines that should be billable to the City of Philadelphia.

Answer:

The amount of time in which a vendor is preparing a written estimate for the repair services to be provided during the contract should be factored into the applicable hourly rates listed in Section 5, Pricing. There will be no separate charge for written estimates permitted during the contract.

Question #6

What type of internet access will be provided in the Service shop? If it is what is currently in the shop, how can we get an upgrade?

Answer:

There will be No Internet access provided by the City for the Service Shop. Any Internet Access service to be provided shall be at the option and expense of the awarded vendor.

BID REVISIONS

Paragraph 2.1.2 is hereby Revised as follows:

The estimated number of Technicians that may be required on-site during the various shifts at the Philadelphia International Airport as follows:

Two (2) Technicians (7:00 AM to 3:00 PM Shift, Monday through Friday)

One (1) Technician (3:00 PM to 11:00 PM Shift, Monday through Friday)

And

"On-Call Service" Technicians as required:

The successful Primary bidder shall be available to provide "On Call Service" during standard and outside of than standard operating hours to the City of Philadelphia. This may be accomplished by having designated individuals on call who have the authority and knowledge, when required, to provide repairs and/or equipment replacement. Security Clearance ID Badges will be required for all Technicians providing repair services at the Philadelphia International Airport.
