ADDENDUM # 2

TO ALL BIDDERS:

You are hereby notified of the following changes to the above mentioned bid:

Bid S2Z57620 postponed until further notice is now scheduled to open on **July 25, 2011 at 10:30AM.**

Page 10, item #2.2.1.3, is to be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“Under this contract, the City will not purchase any paging equipment (pager). The acquisition cost shall be the equipment usage charge.”

Page 18, item #2.6.1, is to be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“The City will not purchase any paging instruments, and instruments’ usage charges and other necessary and incidental charges shall be taken into account in figuring out the bid pricing. **It is the bidders’ responsibility to include all charges, costs, taxes, surcharges and government fees as an integral part of a single price in Section 5.**”

It is estimated that ten (10) digital numeric pagers and eight (8) digital 2-way device type II will be lost, stolen, and/or damaged during a twelve (12) month period. The initial ten (10) digital numeric pagers that are lost, stolen, and/or damaged during a twelve (12) month period shall be provided at no additional cost to the City. **For any additional digital numeric pager, other than the initial ten (10), that is lost, stolen, and/or damaged during a twelve (12) month period, the City will compensate the vendor per price bid in Section 5. (See #5.4.1)**

The initial eight (8) digital 2-way device type II that are lost, stolen, and/or damaged during a twelve (12) month period shall be provided at no additional cost to the City. **For any additional digital 2-way device type II, other than the initial eight (8), that is lost, stolen, and/or damaged during a twelve (12) month period, the City will compensate the vendor per price bid in Section 5. (See #5.4.2)”**

Page 27, item #5.1, the following sentence is to be deleted:

“The City will be responsible to pay only for two (2) simplified items listed and priced in the following (See para. #2.6.1):”

Page 27, add the following language:

5.4 Lost/Stolen/Damaged Devices

Bidder shall state the unit price for any lost, stolen, or damaged device in addition to the initial estimated amount. (See #2.6.1)

Questions & Answers

Question 1: (Page 13, item #2.3.4, para. #2) Please clarify the requirement stated since pagers do not operate on a PCS band.

Answer: That paragraph should read, "Instruments shall be capable of operating on a paging network or PCS band, if necessary, to provide complete and continuous operation over the Local and Nationwide coverage areas."

Question 2: We would like to request to qualify the SunTelecom ST-902 as an acceptable device over the M-90. Item #2.3.5 (2) from page 15 seems to refer to the M-90.

Answer: Vendor can provide equivalent device, but must meet all of the requirements listed in Section 2.

Question 3: In regards to the optional features listed on pages 15 & 16, is the City requesting a price list for those features or is the City requesting that some, all or none of them be included in the base rate?

Answer: All pricing should be embedded in the base rate.

Question 4: Page 18 (item #2.5.4) lists 800 numbers as being an option but the bid document does not indicate they are required as with voice mail (item #2.4.5). Do the fees for 800 numbers need to be included for two way pagers or as a separate charge for an optional service?

Answer: All fees should be embedded in the pricing.

Question 5: Please confirm if the following language can be added in Section 5. It can be titled "Section 5.4: Lost/Stolen/Damaged Beyond Repair Equipment Charges"

 "5.4.1 Numeric loss fee


 5.4.2 Two way loss fee"

Answer: See above. Item #5.4 "Lost/Stolen/Damaged Devices" is being added to Section 5.

Question 6: Regarding Section 2.6.1, if the City loses more devices than the estimate stated in this section, will the bidder have the right to bill for the additional lost devices?

Answer: Yes. See above for a revised Section 2.6.1.
