You are hereby notified of the following changes to the above mentioned bid:


Bid #S3YB5530, Laboratory Testing Services, is now scheduled to open on June 6, 2012 at 10:30 A.M.

Paragraph 1.2 (Contract Term) shall be deleted, in its entirety, and replaced with the following paragraph:

- 1.2 **CONTRACT TERM:** 07/01/2012 to 06/30/2013 (“Initial Term”), with an option to renew for up to three (3) additional one (1) year periods, (“the Renewal Term”) exercisable, at the City’s sole discretion, as of the expiration of the Initial Term or then current Renewal term. The City may, at its sole discretion, renew the contract for up to three (3) months at the beginning of each renewal period(s) (the “Additional Performance Period”), if a decision has been made not to renew the contract for an entire year.

Response to questions for RFP #S3YB5530 (key = Q/A)

With regard to #7 on page 10 of the City's bid for Laboratory Testing Services, S3YB5530 - the expectations for the bid are for the interface to be operational on the first day of this contract. How many tests built and interfaced would the Public Health Laboratory consider to have the interface operational? It could theoretically be considered operational with just one test. Would the expectation be something more than that?

The expectation is the 350 highest volume tests.

What are the constituents of antibody panels 1 and 2? (item numbers 5.1.119, 5.1.208)

These tests are for RBC antibody testing. Some patients will have 1 Antibody and others have 2 or more Antibodies. Submit the charges for each antibody identified.

What is the shared assay comp? (item number 5.1.121)

This is a charge for isolation, extraction and/or purifications of DNA or RNA.

What stops (addresses) are going to be a regular pick up for the specimens on a daily basis Monday through Friday?

500 s Broad - 3rd floor and 1st floor
Mazzoni Center - 809 Locust and south 12th Street

What is considered a cancelled test?

Any test request that is unable to be performed.

What type of specific PAP testing is performed?

Liquid PAP with reflex to HPV

Clarification is needed on the following tests:

- Drug screen 5.1.51
 - Serum sample without conformation
 - Tests: acetaminophen, barbiturates, benzodiazepines, salicylates, tricyclic antidepressants, volatiles
- Respiratory Allergy Profile Region 1 5.1.112

- IgE allergy testing for: Alternaria alternate, Aspergillus fumigatus, Bermuda grass, Birch, Cat dander, Cladosporium herbarum, Cockroach, Common ragweed, Cottonwood, Dermatophagoides farinae, Dermatophagoides pteronyssinus, Dog dander, Elm, Maple, Mountain cedar, Mugwort, Oak, Pencillium notatum, Rough pigweed, sheep sorrel, sycamore, Timothy grass, Walnut tree, White ash, White mulberry.
